### MOVING OUT OF DISTRICT?

If you are a current 9th, 10th, or 11th grader and your family is moving out of district for the next school year, please have your guardian contact the school registrar, Julie Peterburs. There is paperwork that needs to be filled out to make your move a smooth transition!

### A REMINDER FROM THE NURSE'S OFFICE

**Juniors** - Please schedule your appointment for your Meningococcal Vaccine. All Students entering grade 12 in the State of Illinois must be immunized for meningitis. A dose of this vaccine must be received on/after their 16th birthday. Proof of receiving the MCV4 vaccination (s) is required prior to the first day of school beginning in the fall of 2018. According to District 303 policy students without proof of receiving the MCV4 vaccination will be excluded from school. The only exceptions are students with an approved medical or religious exemption on file with the school nurse or students with an appointment to receive the MCV4 documented by the student's healthcare provider and submitted to the school nurse.

**Freshman** - Please schedule your appointment for your 9th grade physical. According to District 303 policy, freshmen are not allowed to attend school until the school nurse has a copy of their complete physical on the State of Illinois Certificate of Child Health Examination form. An athletic physical does NOT fulfill this requirement. The form is located on the district website [Link to Child Health Examination Form](#)

### **PARKING PERMIT INFORMATION - WILL BE INCLUDED IN REGISTRATION MATERIALS**

Future Seniors (**Class of 2019**) interested in every day parking on campus during 2018-19 MUST turn in their parking permit application (pink sheet) and have all their registration fees paid by the deadline of July 17, 2018. If there are more applications received than available spaces, a lottery will be used to determine who has the opportunity to park every day. Seniors who will be issued an every day hang tag will receive an e-mail prior to Materials Pick-up days. Seniors who do not get an every day tag may have the option to purchase two hang tags for the Driver's Ed Range (Odd/Even) after the start of school for the price of two Range tags.

Future Juniors (**Class of 2020**) will have the opportunity to purchase an Odd or Even hang tag for the Driver's Ed Range. Juniors need to turn in their parking permit application (pink sheet) and pay all their registration fees by the deadline of July 17, 2018 prior to receiving their hang tag at Materials Pick-up.

Saints - Parking on campus is a privilege that may be revoked for a variety of violations. Parking violation consequences will range from warnings, AMAs, PMAs, Saturday School, Permit suspensions, loss of Permit and/or having your vehicle towed at your expense. Consequences will be based on the severity and/or frequency of the violation. Parking guidelines will be clearly communicated on the back of the parking permit application (pink sheet) and given to students when they pick up their hang tag at Materials Pick-up. Students and parents are responsible for signing and understanding all parking expectations.

### **YEARBOOK DISTRIBUTION**

Our yearbook is a "Fall Delivery". Books are shipped directly to Seniors' homes, and distributed to the underclassmen at Materials Pick-up in August. If you did not pre-purchase a yearbook, you can also purchase one in the Fall for \$50 (ONLY if extras are available).

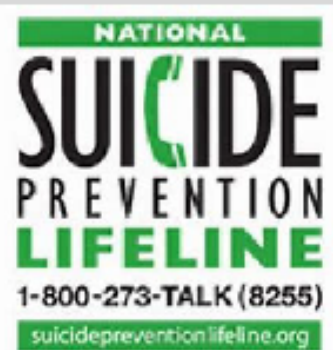
