Dear Parents & Guardians,

The faculty and staff of St. Charles East High School cordially invite you to participate in Student-Parent-Teacher Conferences on Monday, November 21, 2016, between 11:30 a.m. – 7:30 p.m. This is an opportunity for you to meet on an individual basis with your child's teachers and other school personnel to discuss their academic performance. We encourage you to attend conferences with your son/daughter.

In order to provide an opportunity for you to meet with all of your child's teachers, you will need to sign up for 10 minute conferences through Home Access Center (HAC) under the "School Links" tab. Please select the "Parent Teacher Conference Schedule". You will be prompted to enter your e-mail and select a password. You will be able to sign up for conferences starting Monday, October 24, 2016, and it will close on Wednesday, November 16, 2016. Should you have a need for a conference lasting longer than 10 minutes, please schedule an alternate conference on another date directly with the teacher. If you do not have access to Home Access Center, please contact Joan Barley at 331-228-5509 for assistance.

Please follow the directions on the next page in order to sign up for your conferences. You will need to build in a break between your conference times in order to travel from location to location. As you schedule your conferences, you may print or email your schedule through the "Printable Schedule" page. This page will contain the times, teachers and locations of your conferences.

While traveling throughout the building during the conference day, please take a few minutes to visit with the personnel in the Learning Resource Center, Student Services, and the Administrative offices. We look forward to your visit, and trust your conferences will provide you with a valuable link to your child's education.

Finally, Tuesday, November 22, 2016 is a School Improvement Day for all high school staff members; students are not in attendance the entire week of November 21-25.

Directions for Scheduling Parent-Teacher Conferences

Accessing the Parent-Teacher Schedule

1. Log into Home Access Center (HAC)
2. From the Home screen, click on "School Links"
3. Click on "Parent-Teacher Conference Schedule"

Register (new users):

1. Enter your email address and click "Login/Create Account"
2. Fill in the required fields and register

Signing in (returning users)

If you have previously registered, enter your email and password. If you have forgotten your password, you can select the "Forgot Password" button and a new password will be mailed to you.

Identify Student

For each child, enter a Student ID and Birthdate (mm/dd/yy)

Scheduling

1. Each colored square represents an available meeting time. The legend shows you which teacher corresponds to which color, and the times increase as you go down the page. (Note: You will not see all of the teachers at your school, just your children's teachers.)
2. Click on a square to book that time.
3. Click "Create Appointment". The square corresponding to your conference time will turn black.
4. Repeat for each teacher with whom you would like to meet.
5. Click on "Printable Schedule" and print the resulting web page to get a hard copy of your schedule. On this screen, you may select to email yourself the schedule.

Other Information

1. Click on "Your Schedule" to display information (such as time, date and room number), cancel or change the time of your appointments.
2. You will receive a reminder e-mail near the date of your conference.
