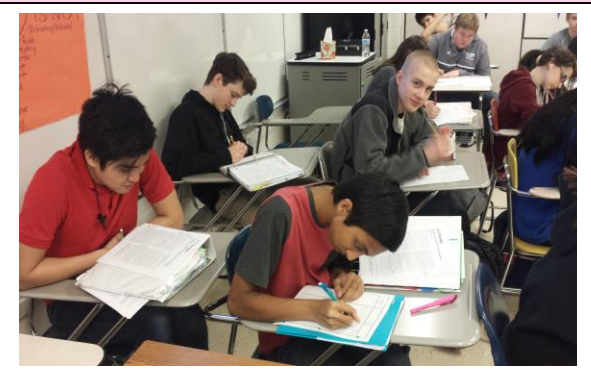

## WHAT'S UP?

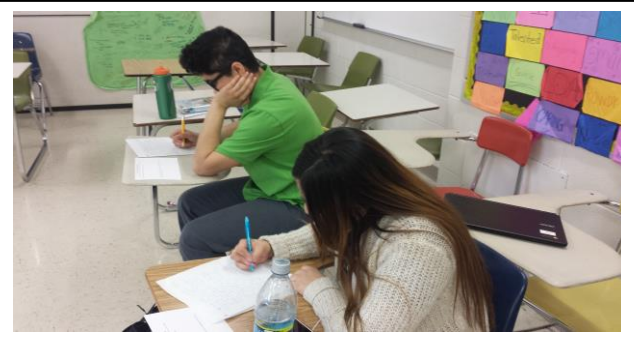
**AVID Freshmen** have been working on WICOR activities through AVID Weekly articles.
